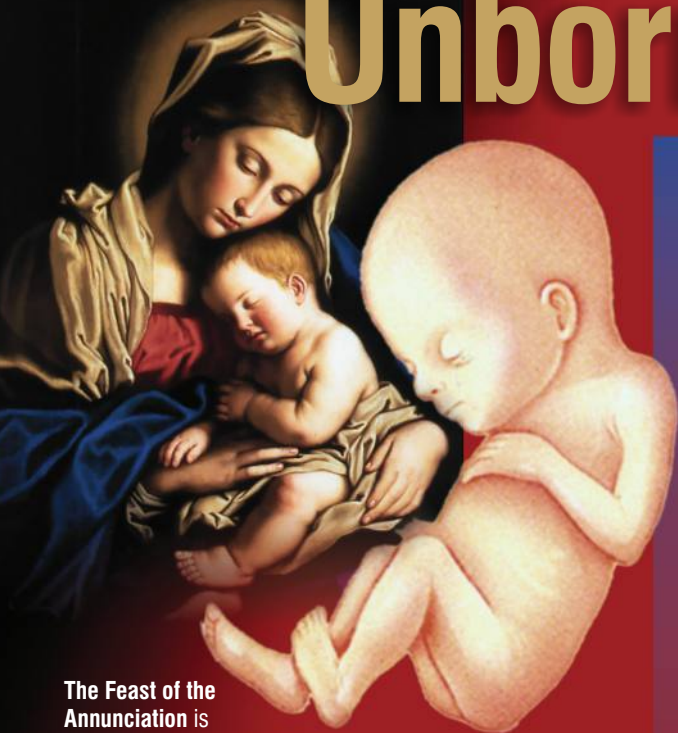


Day of the Unborn Child
